There are three defined levels of giving and recognition in the Cornerstone Society:

Golden Pillar	\$2,000 and up
Silver Pillar	\$1,000 to \$1,999
Bronze Pillar	\$250 to \$999

These philanthropic contributions assist United Way in providing the financials support to the health and human service agencies in our community.

The Cornerstone Society was expanded in 1998 to include employee giving. Many individuals' give and United Way wanted a way to recognize groups of individuals who give from various companies. Therefore, a new group was created to the many individuals who give. The same level of giving was maintained for this group.
